### Code of Ethic

The Institut Mozdahir International (IMI) is an apolitical, non-profit non-governmental organization.

IMI aims to put the experience, competence and the know-how of its members to the service of equitable and durable human development across the world and in Africa in particular. As such, the IMI promotes programs aimed at improving the living conditions of the most disadvantaged population, while respecting the laws and regulations in force.

The common bond between the Members of the IMI (hereinafter referred to as Members) is born out of the ideal and philosophy of Ahl Al Bayt, a philosophy of universal love, peace, sharing and tolerance.

As an extension of their definitive and firm commitment to conform to the stipulations and statutes of the IMI's internal regulations, the Members pledge to respect and implement the principles and values outlined in this Code of Ethics. The Members imperatively commit to these principles in order to become Ambassadors of Peace and Tolerance at the service of the well-being of humanity as a whole.

This commitment is carried to the highest level of IMI as evidenced by the signing of this Code of Ethics by its Founding President.

Any Member found to adhere and spread ideals contrary to the principles and values established by this Code of Ethics, may be subject to a disciplinary procedure which may result in definitive exclusion in accordance with the stipulations of the statutes of the NGO.

#### ● Respect of laws and regulations

The IMI carries out missions handed to it in compliance with the laws and regulations specific to the countries in which it operates. Missions are handled with integrity and respect for all stakeholders involved in the project.



● **Respect for persons**

The IMI is first and foremost a place of life which puts the wellbeing of people in all its dimensions at the center of its purpose.

Beyond respect for the laws and regulations applicable to the countries in which the IMI may operate, the organization encourages and promotes respect for others and the environment in all its aspects.

During events organized by the IMI, Members ensure that they always communicate in a pedagogical manner. That they maintain good listening and an open mind favorable to the building of a multicultural social connection with no discrimination.

The IMI work with populations in need with no discrimination or distinction as to their nationality, ethnicity, sex, religion, social condition or political affiliation, institutional or philosophical.

● **Respect for the environment**

The IMI takes into account the environmental impact of each of its actions and ensures to the best of its ability reduced waste of resources.

Every Member is to participate in the implementation of measures taken by the IMI in order to protect the environment and promote sustainable development. Members are encouraged to utilize best practices when it comes to the environment, including reducing consumption, reducing waste production and selective sorting of waste.

● **Apolitical and pacifist**

The IMI is an apolitical and pacifist NGO, as such the organization dissociates itself from all political parties, philosophical or religious, which may promote intolerance and radical ideas.

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● **Independence**


The IMI is a complimentary actor to the public authorities unaffiliated with any institutions or political parties.

The IMI retains autonomy and independence from all powers whether political, philosophical, economic or trade union.
